The Arabic Music Retreat has a <u>limited</u> number of <u>partial</u> scholarships for the 2025 Retreat. These are **partial awards** and will not cover the entire fee for the Retreat. Awards are subject to the availability of scholarship funds and the quality of the applicants, and will be awarded at the discretion of the directors. <u>Preference will be given to applicants who have previously attended the Arabic Music Retreat, are involved in education (particularly music education), and can demonstrate financial need.</u>

- > All scholarship recipients will stay in the dormitory; both single and double occupancy rooms in the dorm are available to scholarship recipients.
- > Recipients must attend the entire Retreat; part-time attendance will not be permitted.
- All scholarships will be awarded in exchange for part-time work at the Retreat. All recipients will be expected to help with staff functions, primarily related to set-up, check-in and checkout, daily classroom coordination, open mics and concert crew. These activities will not interfere with your Retreat participation and are a fun way to get to know other Retreaters. Kay Campbell will assign you to a team and will organize the tasks to run smoothly. In addition to the tasks you choose below, we may assign you to other work if needed.

From the list below, please choose two teams that you would be willing to join. We will try to match

you with your choices, and we may ask you to participate in more than one area. If you have questions about these duties please contact: arabicmusicretreat@gmail.com. Check-in Team: Arrive by noon on Saturday, help check participants in. This is a team effort and will continue until dinner time. We will also need someone on the team to help drive people to the dorms with their luggage. **Check-out Team:** On the final morning assist with receiving keys and cards from participants checking out. Set-up and Tear-down Team: On Saturday afternoon, set up classrooms and stage with music stands and chairs. During the week, arrange furniture for Open Mic nights in Willits and move them back to original position; set up stage for concerts and move chairs and music stands during and after the concerts. **Open Mic Team** - Solicit participants, organize the play-list, announce and introduce the events. We will have two Open Mic nights, plus the final after-recital party that may need some subtle management. Must generate enthusiasm, try to maximize participation and keep the evenings moving at a good pace. Concert Crew Team - Helps move chairs on and off stage, following direction of stage manager and faculty. Troubleshoot during concert as necessary. **Concert Recording** – Helps set up mics on stage before and during concerts.
